

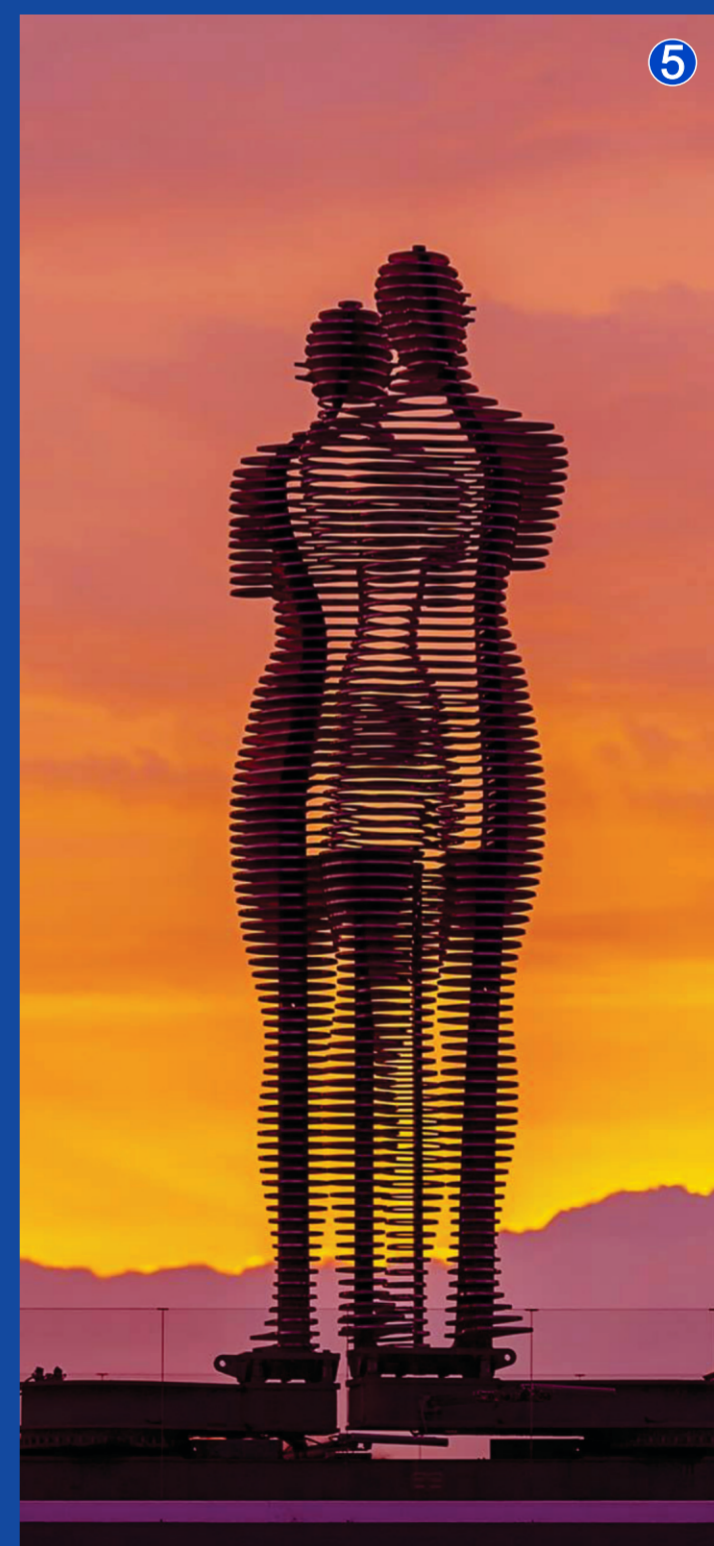

GEORGIAN HOSPITALITY AND GOODWILL

Georgia situated along the eastern coast of the Black Sea on the crossroad between Europe and Asia is one of the most ancient countries in the world. Exceptional hospitality and goodwill of the Georgian people make every trip very special. According to an ancient Georgian proverb 'visitors are sent from the God'.

EASY VISA REGIME

Due to Georgia's track record with security reforms, Georgia has become one of the safest countries in the world. The VISA policy of Georgia is comparatively liberal, allowing citizens from 98 countries to enter without visa or resident permit.



GEORGIAN CULTURE

Georgia is a place of unparalleled culture, traditions, rich history, Georgian folk dances and polyphonic singing. Georgia as one of the first countries in the world to adopt Christianity in 4th century, which has had a significant influence on Georgian culture. Here, you will find ancient architectural sites as it is Gonio, inhabited in 8th-7th c. BCE. Moreover, Georgian polyphonic singing and unique Georgian alphabet are part of the UNESCO Intangible Cultural Heritage List.

FIRST EUROPEANS

Georgia had been named as a cradle of European civilization. By reason of ancient human skulls found in Georgia, which date back to 1.8 million years, the experts believe, that Georgia is the birthplace of first Europeans.



SKI RESORTS

Georgia has 4 ski resorts in different regions: Gudauri, Bakuriani, Goderdzi and Svneti. The Svneti region has the highest mountain named Shkhara, standing 5,068 m above the sea level, as well as the highest inhabited village in Europe called Ushguli at 2,300 m.

- Gudauri - 2,200 m (64 km ski runs)
- Bakuriani - 1,700 m (13,5 km ski runs)
- Goderdzi - 2,350 m (8 km ski runs)
- Svneti, Hatsvali – 3,248 m (7 km ski runs)

AJARA REGION

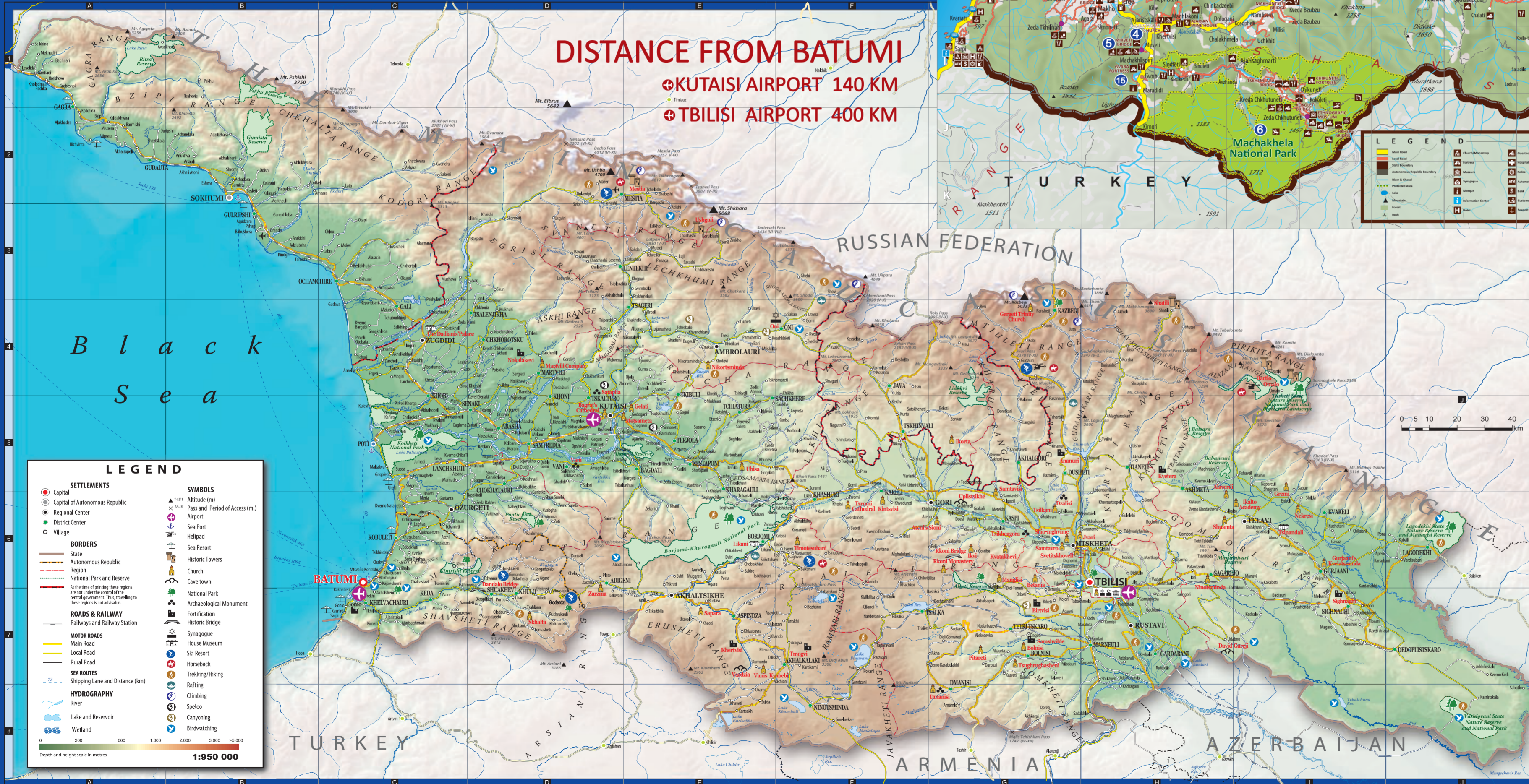
